

GOVERNOR GENERAL: MR. CARLYLE A. GLEAN

Carlyle Arnold Glean of St. Dominic's Street, Gouyave, became Grenada's 5th Governor General and Gouyave's 2nd.

He took the oath of office in front of a packed Grenada Trade Center on Thur. 27th Nov.

Both houses of parliament met for the special occasion.

In his first speech, he said he was grateful to almighty God for his mercies and for bringing him thus far, he also pledged to uphold the honour and dignity of the office of Governor General and to serve his country to the best of his ability.

Mr. Glean took over from Sir. Daniel C. Williams, who served from 8th August 1996 to 17th November 2008.

The other Gouyavarian to serve in that post, Sir Paul Scoon, who served from 30th September 1978 to 6th August 1992, was in attendance at the ceremony.

Mr. Glean will be knighted by her Majesty the Queen, at a later date.

A former school teacher, principal, university lecturer and Education Minister, he was born 11th February 1932 in Gouyave. He is married to Norma De Coteau and is the father of Five children.
